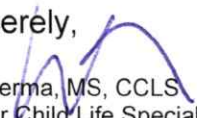
Dear Members of the Zitwer Foundation,

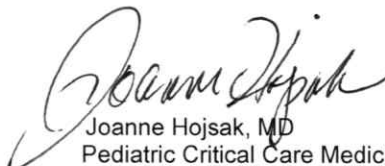

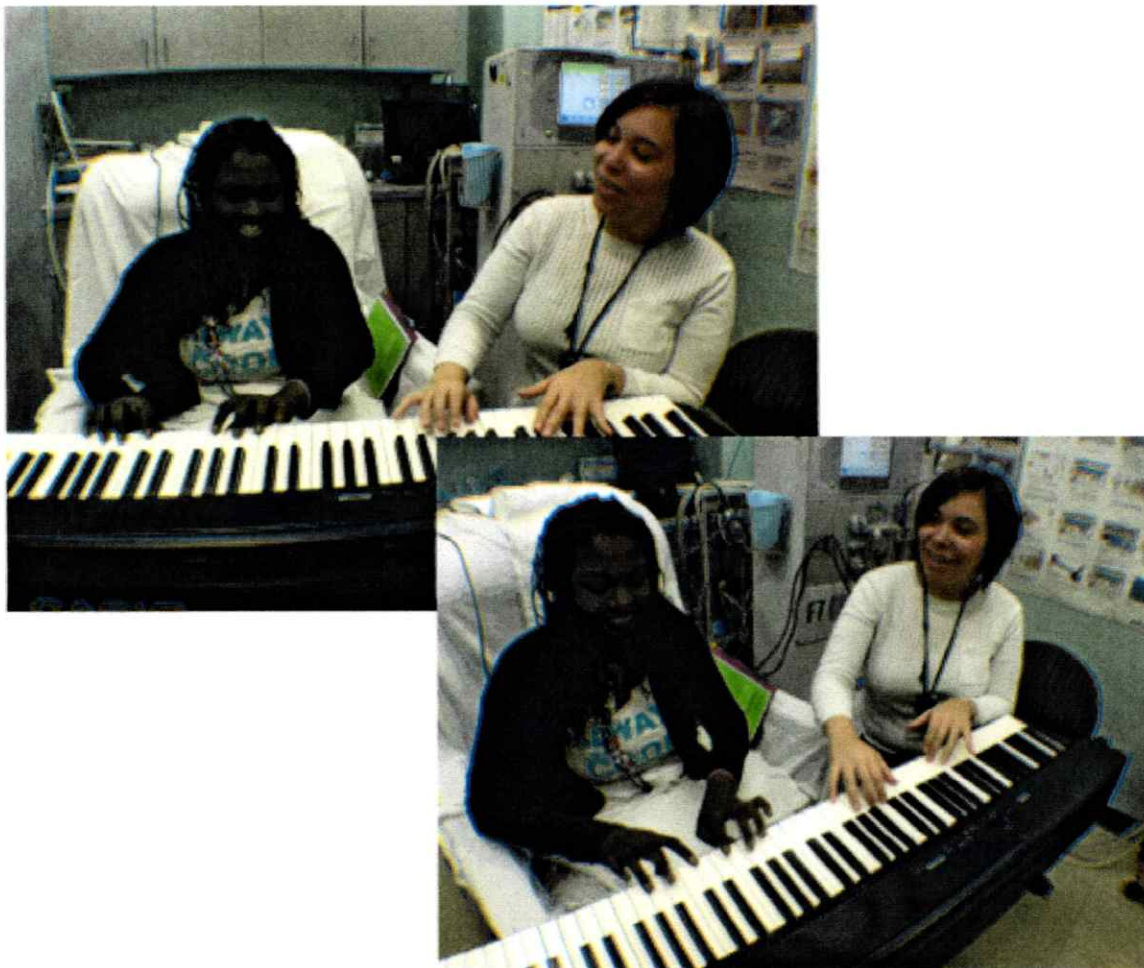

The fun hats for children that participate in the live broadcast studio are wonderful. Not only will these hats offer a fun and exciting incentive to participate in trivia shows and the live KidZone TV programming, the process of creating the hats was a treat for patients. Two patients submitted art for the hats and were just delighted to hear that their art would be displayed for other children to enjoy. The new Healing through Hands weaving program continues to flourish! 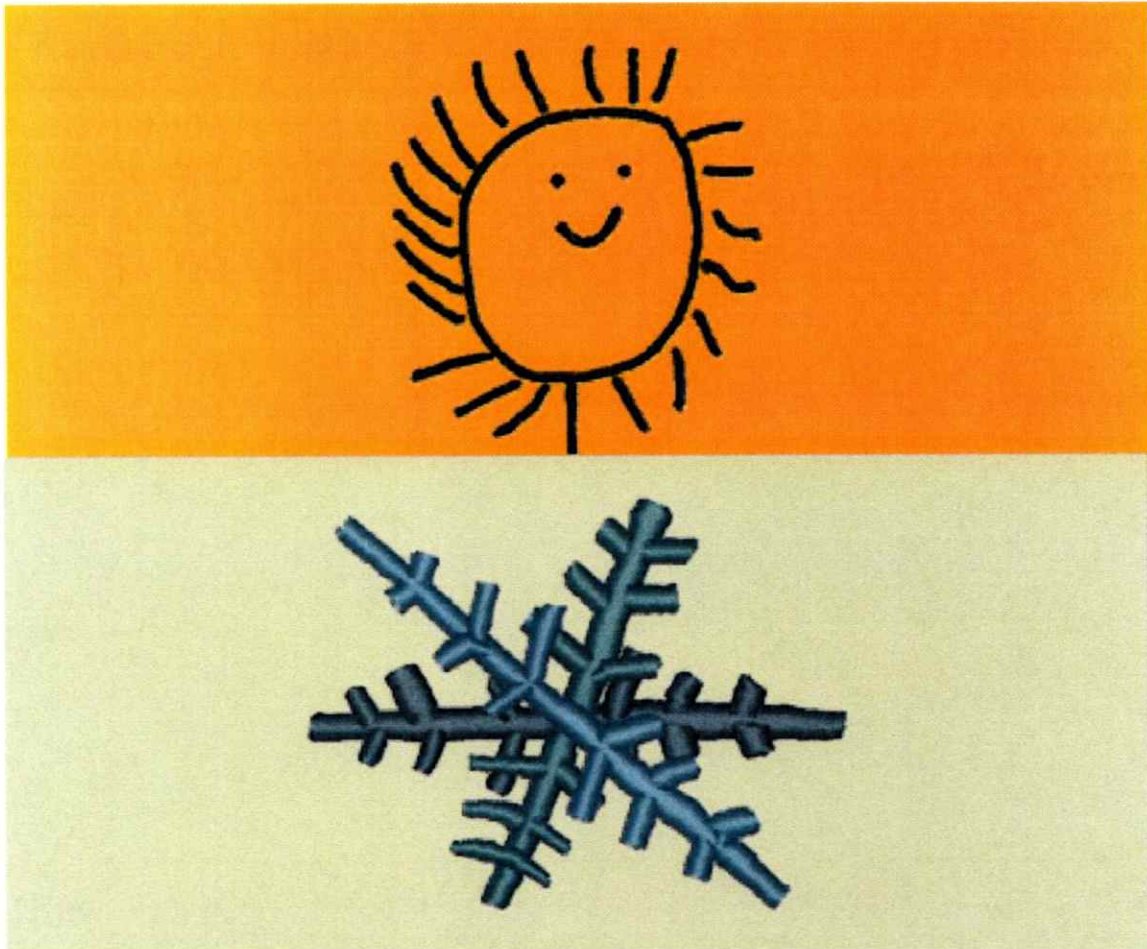
